Setup multi-factor authentication 1. Download any of these authenticator apps on your phone or tablet from your app store: FreeOTP, Google Authenticator, Microsoft Authenticator 2. Use your authenticator app to scan the QR code below. If you can't use a QR code, enter the secret key into the app instead. Secret key: J53X 052S OFRG 2VTE PE3E E53E KRIX IQ3P 3. The authenticator app will show a security code. Enter the 6digit code. 6-digit code Enter the 6-digit code Device name (optional) Device name helps you manage your OTP devices.
